Entries will be received at the Exhibition Hall on Tuesday Sept 1, 4pm-8 pm only.

Judging takes place on Wednesday, Sept 2

**Open to public Thursday, 11am -8 pm,
Friday, 10am-9pm, Saturday, 11am- 8 pm, Sunday.
10am- 12pm**

Pick up Sunday 1 pm-3pm.

Entry Fee is \$1 per entry per item.

Exhibitor passes are available for the week at \$10.00 with the entry of at least one item listed.

Exhibition hall will be *closed* to the public at **12:00pm on Sunday, Sept 6** Exhibitors may remove their exhibits from **1:00pm to 3:00pm. All exhibits must be removed by 3:00pm on Sunday. Prize money should also be picked up at this time**

All items exhibited at owners' risk.

All exhibitors *aged 14 and under* please put age on entry form and entry tags.

Judges' decisions are final.

Department Rules:

- Styrofoam display trays & wooden potato boxes will be supplied.
- Potatoes should be brushed clean with a soft brush and preferably not washed.
- Onions should be brushed clean with a soft brush. Only ragged and dirty outer scales should be removed. *Do not peel.*
- Celery and Swiss Chard should be exhibited in a large jar/vase.
- Trays and boxes will be provided by the Exhibition.
