All angel food cakes must be made from fresh ingredients – no mixes. A minimum of 1/8 of a 10-inch tube pan cake must be submitted for judging.

Class 17

Family Favorite Cake Recipe Baking Contest Prizes: 1st - \$5.00 2nd - \$3.00 3rd - \$2.00

1. Homemade Cake (no mixes please)- 4" Piece.

Department Rules:

Entry tags must be taped to plastic coverings.

Two or more pieces comprising one entry must be securely fastened together.

Please put food entries on small paper plates or foam meat trays and place in **clear** plastic bag- ziplock bags are preferred. *No saran wrap please.*

Jams, jellies, and pickles must be properly sealed in canning jars with two-piece metal snap lids. Unsealed jar items will not be accepted. Any size of jar is acceptable.

Note: All jams, jellies, and pickles must be properly labeled. Labels **must** include type (*example: strawberry jam/mustard pickles/etc.*) and the date (*year and month*) the product was made. All products must be made between September 2025 and August 2026.

Baked items must be of a non-perishable nature. *Refrigeration is not available.*

Remove muffin papers before exhibiting.

Two exhibits made from the same batch are **not** acceptable. Two exhibitors cannot enter something from the same loaf, etc. All items in jars must be dated with the year and month when made.

Judging will be based on appearance, taste, texture, and recipe creativity.

General Regulations:

Entries will be received at the Exhibition Hall on Tuesday Sept 1, 4pm-8 pm only.

Judging takes place on Wednesday, Sept 2

Open to public Thursday, 11am -8 pm, Friday, 10am-9pm, Saturday, 11am- 8 pm, Sunday. 10am- 12pm

Pick up Sunday 1 pm-3pm.

Entry Fee is \$1 per entry per item.

Exhibitor passes are available for the week at \$10.00 with the entry of at least one item listed.

Exhibition hall will be *closed* to the public at **12 :00pm on Sunday, Sept 6** Exhibitors may remove their exhibits from **1:00pm to 3:00pm. All exhibits must be removed by 3:00pm on Sunday. Prize money should also be picked up at this time**

All items exhibited at owners' risk.

All exhibitors *aged 14 and under* please put age on entry form and entry tags.

Judges' decisions are final.
