

Future Farmer Competition

Rules & Regulations

Open to youth ages 7–21 as of January 1, 2026.

Competitors must enter:

- A minimum of one livestock, light horse, or beef.
- The Christmas Tree Competition, held in memory of Keith Moore.
- A minimum of one Life Skills project in any category.
- A speaker session and complete a quiz.

Note: Speaker time, name, and location are to be determined.

Entry fees for each class are payable to the committee running that division. The Future Farmer entry fee is \$5 and must be paid when the entry form is submitted to the exhibition. Competitors who do not complete an entry form or pay the required fee will not be considered for the competition.

Points:

- Light Horse: Competitor's top three placings.
- Beef: Competitor's showmanship placing.
- Christmas Tree/Life Skills: One point automatically awarded for entering, plus up to five points for placing: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point

Prizes:

All points will be tallied, and prizes will be awarded courtesy of Farm Credit Canada. Prizes will be presented on *Sunday, September 6th*.

- **Champion = \$50**
- **Reserve Champion = \$30**
- **Honourable Mention = \$20**
